- ___ FCSA application <http://www.fcsa.biz/apply.shtml>
- ___ Photocopies of academic documents. Please include transcript (course listing with grades and credits) and diploma and remember to copy both the back and front of each document.
- ___ Certified English translations, if necessary. If your documents are in Spanish, you may translate them yourself.
- ___ Syllabus (course descriptions) of your studies from the year of graduation
- ___ Fee for a detailed evaluation (\$110 payable by check, credit card or money order)

If you are licensed to teach in your home country, you also need to submit:

- ___ Teaching license or equivalent
- ___ Statement of good standing in the teaching profession in your home country.

Evaluations will be completed about two weeks after file is complete. Rush service is available. Please see application for fee schedule and mailing options.
